Mr. Ib Petersen is State Secretary for Development Policy in the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs. He was the State Secretary for Development Cooperation, Middle East, Africa, Asia, Latin America and the United Nations from 2007-2009. Mr. Ib Petersen has a long carrier within International Development, holding positions as Under Secretary for Bilateral Development Cooperation (2004-2007), Head of Department, Policy & Planning (2001-2004) and Deputy Head of Department, Policy & Planning (1998-2001).

From 1995-1998 Mr. Ib Petersen was Deputy Head of Mission at the Royal Danish Embassy in Harare. Prior to this he functioned as Head of Section in the Asia Department from 1992-1995, Head of Section in the Department for EU Internal Policies from 1991-1992 and was Executive Director's Assistant in the Nordic Office at the World Bank in Washington D.C. 1988-1991. His carrier started as Head of Section in the Department for Multilateral Development Banks, (Danida) in the Danish Ministry of Foreign Affairs. A position he held from 1985-1988.
